Guide to the E. Harvey Estes Interview, 2004

### Biographical/Historical Note

Edward Harvey Estes was born in Gay, Ga. in 1925 and graduated from Emory University in Atlanta, Georgia (B.A., M.D.). He began his medical internship at Grady Memorial Hospital in Atlanta, and completed it at Duke University Hospital.

Dr. Estes joined Duke's staff in 1953. He became chief of the cardiology service at Durham Veterans Affairs Hospital (1953-1954) and chief of the medical service at the (1958-1963). In 1966, Estes was selected to serve as the chair of Department of Community and Family Medicine at Duke University Medical Center, a position that he held until 1985.

Dr. Estes is past president of the Medical Society of the State of North Carolina as well as the North Carolina Heart Association. He is a member of a many other professional organizations and has authored or co-authored over 100 scientific articles.
